We offer arrange of treatment and support services, providing help in a friendly, non judgemental way. We also offer support to families and concerned others if this is asked for.

The service will respond quickly to any referral and can also signpost people to other services as required, such as BAS.







Alcohol and Drug Treatment Service

- · Recovery planning and support.
- Advice and information to help individuals cut down or stop.
- Alcohol brief interventions.
- Sexual Health advice and free condoms.
- Free access to injecting equipment, including steroid users.
- Free naloxone training this can save a life in the event of an opiate overdose.
- · General health checks and wound care.
- Hepatitis and HIV advice and access to treatment.
- Dried Blood Spot Testing for Blood Borne Viruses. Crisis support and intervention.
