

**NHS BORDERS ANNUAL REVIEW 2016
AT A GLANCE TARGET PERFORMANCE IN 2015/16**

- 96.2% of patients waiting in **A&E** waited for **less than 4 hours** during 2015/16.
- **1780 Alcohol Brief Interventions** have been delivered in the period April 2015 to March 2016, 36% above the target of 1312.
- 96 **smokers successfully quit for 12 weeks** in the 40% most deprived quintiles in the period April 2015 to December 2015, better than the target trajectory of 72.
- Patient journeys **from referral to treatment** were **within 18 weeks** for 90.5% of all cases in the period April 2015 to March 2016.
- At 15th March 2016 **4 patients** were waiting **over 2 weeks** after being **ready to be discharged** from hospital into an appropriate care setting.
- 96% of patients **waiting for treatment** after **alcohol or drug referrals** were seen **within 3 weeks** in the period April 2015 to March 2016.
- For November 2014 – October 2015 the number of **emergency occupied bed days** for patients **over 75 reduced** to 3,564 per 1,000 people in the population, compared to the target of 3,685.
- **1040 patients** have been **diagnosed with dementia** and placed on the dementia register as at March 2016 less than the target of 1116.
- In 2015/16 there were 35.4 **identifications of MRSA/MSSA infections** per 100,000 acute occupied bed days **above the target** of 24.0; **C Diff** had 17.5 identifications in the 65+ age group which was **within the target** of 32.0 by March 2016.
- **99.6%** of patients **urgently** referred for **cancer treatment** began treatment **within 31 days** of the decision to treat in the period April 2015 to March 2016.
- During the period April 2015 to March 2016 **90.1%** of all **stroke patients** were **admitted to the stroke unit within one day** of admission to the hospital, better than the target of 90%.
