## Freedom of Information request 93-17

## Request

- 1. [1] In the last three calendar years (2016, 2015, 2014), how many appointments have been missed by patients in the NHS Borders.
  - Can I have a breakdown on the number of appointments missed by each general practice and hospital in the NHS Borders area over last three calendar years (2016, 2015, 2014).
- 2. [2] In the last three calendar years (2016, 2015, 2014) how much has it cost (in pounds) each general practice and hospital within the NHS Borders area.
  - Can I have a breakdown of the total amount of money these missed appointments has cost each general practice and hospital in the NHS Borders area over last three calendar years (2016, 2015, 2014).
- 3. [3] What is the cost for each type of appointment i.e. the price (in pounds) for an appointment with a GP, an outpatient appointment at a hospital and all other types of appointments.

## Response

 The attached report details the number of recorded 'Did Not Attends' for both Nurse Led Clinics and Consultant Outpatient Clinics during 2014 2015 2016. Please note GP Practitioners are Independent Contractors and as such the Board does not hold information on their patient appointments. Therefore under Section 25 of the FOI(S)A 2002 this data is accessible elsewhere.



2. The following tables detail the cost of the DNA's as detailed in the attached report. The total costs detailed have been calculated using the average costs each year relevant to the appropriate lead for the clinic, eq Consultant, Medical Staff, Nurse and Allied Health Professional.

Please state the reference number **93-17** on this request. Your request should be made within 40 working days from receipt of this letter.

If following this review, you remain dissatisfied with the outcome, you may appeal to the Scottish Information Commissioner and request an investigation of your complaint. Your request to the Scottish Information Commissioner should be in writing (or other permanent form), stating your name and an address for correspondence. You should provide the details of the request and your reasons for dissatisfaction with both the original response by NHS Borders and your reasons for dissatisfaction with the outcome of the internal review. Your application for an investigation by the Scottish Information Commissioner must be made within six months of your receipt of the response with which you are dissatisfied.
