

Borders Pet Rescue – Animal Care Assistants

To help care, including grooming, cleaning, socialising and exercising a variety of animals including dogs, cats, rabbits, guinea pigs and hedgehogs. Help support and develop the day-to-day activities of an animal rescue centre.

Gala Harriers – Volunteer in Athletics

Opportunities are available from coaches to technical officials or general club volunteering. It can be marshalling a race to assisting the coach.

BIAS – Board Member

BIAS is looking for enthusiastic individuals to strengthen their Board. You need a commitment to promoting advocacy, helping safeguard peoples' rights, a clear understanding of governance and the ability to think strategically.

RVS – Good Neighbours Community Transport Volunteers

Become a Community Transport Volunteer and help to keep older people in touch with their communities. Community Transport Volunteers are needed to help older people get out and about to stay engaged with their local communities. Typical journeys may include driving someone to a GP appointment, driving them to the shops, taking them to a social club or to visit friends and family.

Borders General Hospital Chaplaincy Centre – Sunday Worship Volunteers

Volunteers will be required to support the attendance of patients at the Sunday Service in wheelchairs and return the patients back to the wards after Sunday worship. The Sunday morning service takes place every week between 11.00 - 11.30 a.m. Volunteers will be required to be there from 10.15 until 11.45 a.m.

Interest Link Borders – Befrienders

Interest Link provides a group and 1:1 befriending service to children, young people and adults with learning disabilities throughout the Scottish Borders. The service is delivered by 200 volunteers, who are supported by Interest Link staff.

Nature Unlimited – Outdoor Volunteer Assistant

Be part of a friendly team facilitating wild play for children aged 6 – 11. Gain confidence in working in a woodland setting and learn new skills such as boiling the Kelly kettle and putting up tarpaulin shelters & hammocks. Assist Nature Unlimited to create a "safe enough" environment for children to learn through play and take appropriate risks.
