Request

I would be grateful if you could provide me with the following information:

- 1. How many claims for medical negligence (excluding vaginal mesh claims) have been intimated to the Health Board in each of the last 3 years?
- 2. How many of those claims have resulted in a payment of compensation being made without court proceedings being raised?
- 3. How many medical negligence cases have progressed to litigation in each of the last 3 years?
- 4. How many of the cases that have been litigated have settled at figures:
 - i. Up to £20k
 - ii. Between £20k and £100k
 - iii. Over £100k

Response

1. Please find below data as per request:

Please state the reference number **213-17** on this request. Your request should be made within 40 working days from receipt of this letter.

If following this review, you remain dissatisfied with the outcome, you may appeal to the Scottish Information Commissioner and request an investigation of your complaint. Your request to the Scottish Information Commissioner should be in writing (or other permanent form), stating your name and an address for correspondence. You should provide the details of the request and your reasons for dissatisfaction with both

the original response by NHS Borders and your reasons for dissatisfaction with the outcome of the internal review. Your application for an investigation by the Scottish Information Commissioner must be made within six months of your receipt of the response with which you are dissatisfied.
