STANDARD CLEANING FOR CLINICAL EQUIPMENT

For all cleaning procedures:-

- Don disposable gloves and plastic apron, consider facial protection if splashing is anticipated
- Assemble cleaning items required: Detergent wipes or general purpose detergent diluted in warm water (dilution instructions on side of container) and sufficient colour coded disposable cloths/paper for both washing and drying
- Prepare Actichlor Plus or Tristel Fuse solution if required for equipment potentially contaminated with infectious organisms.

Between Patient/Client Use

- 1. Clean all surfaces thoroughly then dry with a disposable cloth or absorbent paper.
- 2. Pay particular attention to the areas most frequently touched.
- 3. Dispose of cleaning cloths/ paper in clinical waste.
- 4. If using Actichlor Plus or Tristel Fuse solution, clean as per manufacturers instructions

Weekly Clean

- 1. Clean all surfaces thoroughly then dry with a disposable cloth or absorbent paper.
- 2. Check wheels for build up of debris and remove.
- 3. Report any faults to Estates Helpdesk and remove from use until repaired.
- 4. Dispose of cleaning cloths/ paper in clinical waste.
- 5. Ensure cleaning schedule documentation is completed.
