

## NHS BORDERS ANNUAL REVIEW 2013 AT A GLANCE HEAT TARGET PERFORMANCE AS AT MARCH 2013

- Alcohol brief interventions completed in the year 2012/13 totalled 2,655 compared to the planned 1,247, 113% above target.
- The number of **smokers successfully quitting** for a month in the 40% most deprived quintiles was 779 as at December 2012, 59% **above the target** of 490.
- The number of child healthy weight interventions completed was 121 for 2011/12; 21% above the target of 100.
- Patient journeys from referral to treatment were within 18 weeks for 91% of all cases in March 2013.
- 97% of patients waiting in A&E did so for less than 4 hours at March 2013.
- All patients waiting for treatment by the Child and Adolescent Mental Health Service were seen within 26 weeks in January to March 2013.
- Between January and March 2013 98% of patients waiting for **drugs or alcohol treatment** were seen **within 3 weeks**.
- During 2011/12 94% of patients had access within 48 hours to their GP Practice Team.
- At 15<sup>th</sup> April 2013 **no patients** were waiting **over 4 weeks** to be **discharged** from hospital.
- In December 2012 there were 0.31 identifications of MRSA/MSSA infections per 1,000 acute occupied bed days above the target of 0.26, C Diff rates were 0.44 above the target of 0.39.
- **100%** of patients **urgently** referred for **cancer treatment** began treatment **within 31 days** of decision to treat from September 2012 to March 2013.
- During 2012/13 **91%** of all **stroke patients** were **admitted to the stroke unit within one day** of admission to the hospital.
- In 2012/2013 493 cardiovascular health checks have been completed, 25% above the target of 400.
- In March 2013 there were 943 people on the dementia register.
- The breastfeeding rate at 6 weeks post-birth was **32.4%** in 2011/12, 6.1% above the Scottish average.
