NHS BORDERS ANNUAL REVIEW 2010 AT A GLANCE HEAT TARGET PERFORMANCE AS AT MARCH 2010

- 97.3% of 5 year olds were vaccinated for MMR at during 2009/10.
- The number of smokers successfully quitting for a month was 1,209 as at March 2010, above the target of 888.
- Use of the CHI number of patients records reached 98% by the end of 2009/10
- Patients waiting for an **inpatient treatment** or an **outpatient appointment** all had waits of **less than 9 weeks** by the end of March 2010.
- Patients waiting for a one of 8 key diagnostic tests all had waits of less than 4 weeks by the end of March 2010.
- 97% of patients waiting in A&E did so for less than 4 hours, this performance has increased in recent months.
- The number of **psychiatric patients readmitted** to a ward is **within the plan** at 80 cases, which is better than the target of 199.
- More older patients with complex care needs are being cared for at home, 31% at March 2010.
- At 15th April 2010 no patients were waiting over 6 weeks to be discharged from hospital.
- Rates of C Diff identified in NHS Borders hospitals at March 2010 were within planned levels. Stapphyloccocus aureus bacteraemia identifications were above plan at March 2010 but have reduced recently.
- **98.5**% of patients **urgently** referred for **cancer treatment** were seen **within 62 days** of referral at the end of 2009/10.
- NHS Borders has **significantly reduced** its **energy emissions** during 2009/10. The plan was for a reduction of 4%, 9.7% has been achieved.



Low Smoking 16+ Rates














Number of Mums breastfeeding


