- The number of patients treated as inpatients for mental health problems per year for the last five years
- The average length of stay in inpatient treatment for patients each year for the last five years
- The number of patients as of May 30 who have spent 6 to 12 months in inpatient facilities
- The number of patients as of May 30 who have spent 12 to 18 months in inpatient facilities
- The number of patients as of May 30 who have spent 18 to 24 months in inpatient facilities
- The number of patients as of May 30 who have spent more than 24 months in inpatient facilities

Your request to the Scottish Information Commissioner should be in writing (or other permanent form), stating your name and an address for correspondence. You should provide the details of the request and your reasons for dissatisfaction with both the original response by NHS Borders and your reasons for dissatisfaction with the outcome of the internal review. Your application for an investigation by the Scottish Information Commissioner must be made within six months of your receipt of the response with which you are dissatisfied.
