# **VISITORS: SPEAK TO A NURSE BEFORE ENTERING**



## **DO NOT TAKE PATIENT NOTES INTO ROOM**

### **KEEP EQUIPMENT TO A MINIMUM**

### USE DEDICATED EQUIPMENT WHERE POSSIBLE

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### HANDS

Hand gel or soap and water

If patient has vomiting or diarrhoeal illness, ONLY use soap and water (hand gel is not effective)

### **PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT**



- Apron (gown if required)
- Eye protection if risk of splashing
- Gloves if:
- Contact with blood/body fluids anticipated
- hand wash sink available in room



#### **DOOR TO REMAIN CLOSED**

When door cannot be closed, rationale must be documented in patient notes

- **Discard PPE in clinical waste bin**
- Wash & dry hands or use hand gel







#### **BEFORE ENTERING**

> Patient has a diarrhoeal illness and no clinical

#### **BEFORE LEAVING**

• Decontaminate equipment prior to removal from room
