AIRBORNE PRECAUTIONS



VISITORS: SPEAK TO A NURSE BEFORE ENTERING



DO NOT TAKE PATIENT NOTES INTO ROOM

KEEP EQUIPMENT TO A MINIMUM

USE DEDICATED EQUIPMENT WHERE POSSIBLE



BEFORE ENTERING

HANDS

Hand gel or soap and water

If patient has vomiting or diarrhoeal illness, ONLY use soap and water (hand gel is not effective)




PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

- Wear fitted FFP3 mask
- Wear eye protection (visor if valved FFP3 mask or extensive risk of splashing)
- Wear apron (or gown if AGP or extensive splash/spray anticipated)
- Gloves if:
- Contact with blood/body fluids anticipated
- Patient has a diarrhoeal illness and no clinical hand wash sink available in room



DOOR TO REMAIN CLOSED



BEFORE LEAVING

- Decontaminate equipment prior to removal from room
- Discard apron / gown & gloves in clinical waste bin
- Wash & dry hands or use hand gel

AFTER LEAVING

- Wash & dry hands or use hand gel
- Discard eye protection & mask in clinical waste bin outside room
- Wash & dry hands or use hand gel
