# VISITORS: SPEAK TO A NURSE BEFORE ENTERING



**DO NOT TAKE PATIENT NOTES INTO ROOM** 

**KEEP EQUIPMENT TO A MINIMUM** 

USE DEDICATED EQUIPMENT WHERE POSSIBLE

### **BEFORE ENTERING**



#### **HANDS**

Hand gel or soap and water

If patient has vomiting or diarrhoeal illness, ONLY use soap and water (hand gel is not effective)



#### PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

- Apron (gown if required)
- Fluid resistant Type IIR surgical face mask or for Aerosol Generating Procedures (AGP) wear fitted FFP3 mask
- Eye protection
- Gloves if:
  - Contact with blood/body fluids anticipated
  - Patient has a diarrhoeal illness and no clinical hand wash sink available in room



#### **DOOR TO REMAIN CLOSED**

When door cannot be closed, rationale must be documented in patient notes



#### **BEFORE LEAVING**

- Decontaminate equipment prior to removal from room
- Discard apron / gown & gloves in clinical waste bin
- Wash & dry hands or use hand gel

#### **AFTER LEAVING**

- Wash & dry hands or use hand gel
- Discard eye protection & mask in clinical waste bin outside room
- Wash & dry hands or use hand gel
