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Freedom of Information request 513-19

Request

Under the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 (FOISA), I am requesting details around waiting times for Paediatric Extractions (PEs) of teeth under General Anaesthetic (GA) in each NHS Board.

I would be grateful if you could provide the following information for your NHS Board:

- 1. Number of children who have had teeth extracted under GA in each calendar year since 2014
- 2. Number and age of children waiting for (a) assessment and (b) extractions under GA on 1 October in each year from 2015-19 inclusive (i.e. 5 years' data)
- 3. Average waiting times for the above procedures (same timeframe as above)
- 4. Number of WTE paediatric anaesthetists or other anaesthetists who take part in paediatric procedures (same timeframe as above)
- 5. Number of WTE anaesthetist vacancies (same timeframe as above)
- 6. Number of cancelled theatre sessions for PEs under GA in the 12 months to 1 October 2019, and the total number of patients who were due to be treated during these sessions.
- 7. Number of appointments patients either cancelled or failed to attend for either assessment or extractions in the year up to 1 October 2019.

Your request to the Scottish Information Commissioner should be in writing (or other permanent form), stating your name and an address for correspondence. You should provide the details of the request and your reasons for dissatisfaction with both the original response by NHS Borders and your reasons for dissatisfaction with the outcome of the internal review. Your application for an investigation by the Scottish Information Commissioner must be made within six months of your receipt of the response with which you are dissatisfied.
