## Request

- 1. Can you please disclose (a) the total number of patients in your Health Board that received a continuous glucose monitoring device (excluding flash glucose monitoring devices); and (b) how many of them were pregnant, in each of the following financial years (c) 2018/19 (d) 2019/20.
- 2. Can you please disclose (a) the total number of patients in your Health Board, referred to receive a continuous glucose monitoring device (excluding flash glucose monitoring devices) that have remained on a waiting list for more than 18 weeks; and (b) how many of them were pregnant, in each of the following financial years (c) 2018/19 (d) 2019/20.
- 3. Can you please disclose (a) how many patients in your Health Board with a diagnosis of type 1 diabetes have successfully completed a structured education course (e.g. DAFNE, RECLAIM) in each of the following financial years (b) 2018/19 (c) 2019/20.
- 4. Can you please disclose (a) the number of gestational diabetes-related obstetric complications in pregnant women, recorded in your Health Board, in each of the following financial years (b) 2018/19 (c) 2019/20.
- 5. Can you please disclose (a) how many patients in your Health Board that have been referred to receive a type 1 diabetes structured education course (e.g. DAFNE, RECLAIM) have remained on a waiting list for more than 18 weeks in each following financial years (b) 2018/19 (c) 2019/20.

If following this review, you remain dissatisfied with the outcome, you may appeal to the Scottish Information Commissioner and request an investigation of your complaint. Your request to the Scottish Information Commissioner should be in writing (or other permanent form), stating your name and an address for correspondence. You should provide the details of the request and your reasons for dissatisfaction with both the original response by NHS Borders and your reasons for dissatisfaction with the outcome of the internal review. Your application for an investigation by the Scottish Information Commissioner must be made within six months of your receipt of the response with which you are dissatisfied.
