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Freedom of Information request 151-21

Request

This is an FOI request to understand the number of clinical vacancies at your Health Board.

As of today, 14th April, 2021 please can you advise the total number of WTE (whole time equivalent) vacancies you have for Doctors only. This does not need to be broken down by clinical specialty of directorate but can you provide the total WTE posts that remain vacant based on the below categorisation:

- 1. Consultant grade or similar
- 2. Registrar, Specialty Doctor, Middle-grade, Senior Clinical Fellow, ST3+ or similar
- 3. SHO, Junior Clinical Fellow, ST1/ST2 or similar

Response

As at 14 April 2021, NHS Borders had the following number of whole time equivalent (WTE) vacancies for Doctors only:

- 1. Consultant grade or similar 6.30 WTE.
- 2. Registrar, Specialty Doctor, Middle-grade, Senior Clinical Fellow, ST3+ or similar 1.00 WTE.
- 3. SHO, Junior Clinical Fellow, ST1/ST2 or similar 2.00 WTE.

If you are not satisfied with the way your request has been handled or the decision given, you may ask NHS Borders to review its actions and the decision. The request for a review should include your name and address for correspondence, the request for information to which the request relates and the issue which you wish to be reviewed. Please state the reference number **151-21** on this request. Your request should be made within 40 working days from receipt of this letter.

If following this review, you remain dissatisfied with the outcome, you may appeal to the Scottish Information Commissioner and request an investigation of your complaint. Your request to the Scottish Information Commissioner should be in writing (or other permanent form), stating your name and an address for correspondence. You should provide the details of the request and your reasons for dissatisfaction with both the original response by NHS Borders and your reasons for dissatisfaction with the outcome of the internal review. Your application for an investigation by the Scottish Information Commissioner must be made within six months of your receipt of the response with which you are dissatisfied.
