


Speech Clarity

Sometimes it can be hard to understand your child's speech. We want them to know what they are saying is important. Try not to pretend you have understood; instead tell them you haven't understood or your ears can't hear it. It might be you need to ask them to come back to it later on.

If you do understand the words, but your child says the wrong sounds – just MODEL and REPEAT back the right way e.g. child: "look a back tat", you: "I see the <u>black cat</u>, it's a huge <u>black cat</u>"
