If so should Oxazepam be readily available (stocked in BGH pharmacy and not on any wards) in management of DTs (page 9) there is a statement that there is no max dose for Benzodiapines in DTs with the options being Chlordiazepoxide 30-50mg every 1-2 hours or Lorazepam IM 1-2mg. Is there further information on how this works in clinical practice? Is this common practice? Would there be a stage in treatment where referral to a senior colleague would be indicated? ADTC agreed that this was the correct practice and once clarity is received on the points raised are able to approve the guidance.
