	part of East Region remit, Lothian have proposed their prescribing bulletin could be re-badged			
	and used regionally. Proposal from the editorial team is that they can produce two more editions			
	taking it to the end of this financial year and that future of bulletin should be reviewed before that time. ADTC discussed the requirement for local prescribing information and how a Borders			
	Prescribing Bulletin could be supported going forward. Locally, there are variations and financial			
	improvement plan information that needs to communicate to prescribers. ADTC agreed that			
	there should be local bulletin still going to prescribers and that the current 2-page bulletin			
	emailed works well for those who receive. ADTC approved this direction of travel and will receive			
	update on how the production of Prescribing Bulletin is to continue in future.
