LAUNDRY BAGS SHOULD ONLY BE FILLED TO 2/3 CAPACITY AND MUST BE CORRECTLY SEALED AT WARD/DEPARTMENT. ENSURE ALL SHARP ITEMS AND EXTRANEOUS MATERIAL (PATIENTS TEETH, BOOKS ETC.) ARE REMOVED PRIOR TO PLACING INTO LINEN BAGS
