The Role

These are new opportunities, and you would gain experience in Acute and General Internal Medicine, including sub specialties. This post is not recognised for training purposes but there is an excellent Postgraduate educational programme, good library facilities on site and protected formal teaching within medical unit.

There is a full shift integrated rota for acute medical admissions and you will be a designated Hospital at Night Team Leader after 9.00 pm. The rota is shared with eight colleagues.

You should have recent training grade experience (FY2, ST1, SHO level or equivalent) in acute or general medicine. You should have evidence of achievement of foundation competences and full GMC registration is essential with a licence to practice. The post may be most suitable for doctors at ST2 or ST3 level who are seeking out of programme experience but all appropriately qualified applicants will be seriously considered.
