This is a 12-month Advanced Clinical Fellow in Anaesthesia for Enhanced Recovery After Surgery (ERAS), the Borders General Hospital has established, well regarded and high performing ERAS pathways for arthroplasty, colorectal surgery and hip fracture surgery, and has pathways in development for gynaecology and gynae-oncology, all of which are led by the Anaesthetic Department. An established ERAS audit network facilitates surveillance of the performance of the pathways and ongoing quality improvement. Our department has close ties with the Department of Health in developing ERAS nationally.

A post is available in the grade of Specialty Doctor should you wish to continue at Borders General Hospital after completion of the fellowship. Out of hours commitments are on a 1 in 7 basis shared with senior trainees, specialty doctors and associate specialist colleagues.
