Borders General Hospital is a modern and well-equipped 284 bed DGH serving the rural Borders area in South East Scotland, approximately 36 miles from Edinburgh. After an absence of almost 50 years, the Borders Railway has now opened, with train services to central Edinburgh running every thirty minutes (journey time 50 minutes approx). Tweedbank Station is a few minutes walk from the Borders General Hospital. On opening the railway Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth said "The Borders railway brings so much promise for sharing and invigorating this most beautiful countryside as a place to work, live and enjoy". A relocation package/assistance with temporary accommodation in the local area is available for the successful candidate.

All new consultants are welcome to join the consultant development programme. The programme seeks to provide you with support for the development of leadership and management skills. There are also opportunities for professional coaching and mentoring – an established BGH consultant will be identified as a "buddy" in your first few weeks.

The Role

Building on the excellent work of the first Emergency Medicine Consultant at Borders General Hospital, who established the Emergency Department in 2008, we are seeking to develop the service by recruitment to newly established posts of Consultant in Emergency Medicine. Depending on subspecialty training there are opportunities locally for a sub specialty interest e.g. in intensive care medicine, paediatrics or acute medicine. We are also exploring the sub specialty opportunities with dual site working and network arrangements with NHS Lothian – Edinburgh Royal Infirmary.

You will have shared responsibility for clinical leadership for the management and care of patients in the ED and responsibility for the delivery of all unscheduled care within the department, to meet national targets. This post gives an opportunity to combine hands-on clinical care with leadership of the service. Our Emergency Department provides facilities for the reception, resuscitation, examination and treatment of patients in the Scottish Borders and is well integrated with the Borders Emergency Care Service (BECS), the Primary Care out-of-hours service for Borders. The ED is currently staffed by eleven Specialty Doctors in Emergency Medicine (mostly GP qualified) as well as trainees in Orthopaedics & Trauma.

Candidates must hold FCEM or equivalent and must also be registered with the General Medical Council with a licence to practice on the Specialist Register for Emergency Medicine (or equivalent) before taking up the post or be within 6 months of expected date of obtaining CCT (or equivalent).
