is an employment programme, based on a successful American model, which provides real life work opportunities for young people with additional needs. The course is based at Borders General Hospital. You will get hands on experience of work in the workplace combined with daily classroom sessions.

Areas you may work in include:

- Mail room
- ASDU
- Domestic services
- Porter
- Warehouse and stores
- Administration

Course information

Duration:

One academic year, August 2019 – June 2020, five days per week

Size of group:

8 people

Who is it for?

Young people with additional needs, aged between 17-25, who are nearing the end of their time in education and who are committed and ready to progress into paid employment after the course. Ideally you should be an independent traveller with some previous work experience.

What will you study?

Employability skills such as:

- Customer service
- Communication
- Job search skills
- Interview skills
- Health and safety in the workplace
- Maintaining a healthy working lifestyle.

Where can it lead?

Paid employment, Modern Apprenticeship

Other information:

You will spend two hours each day in the classroom. The rest of the time will be spent in the workplace. You will be given support on the job and the opportunity to try three different job roles. You will be supported full-time by a College tutor and a job coach.
